

Woodside General Meeting
June 1, 2016

The Meeting was called to order

Upon motion, the Minutes from the April 2016 general meeting were approved.

Security Report

Sharon Giordano reported that there were no reports of crime in the past month. Homeowners were informed that “vacation watch” form are available on the Woodside Civic Club website, on Nextdoor or by calling SEAL Security directly.

Finance Report

Marian Richardson reviewed the Treasurer’s report and noted that as of June 1, 2016, there have been 226 homes out of our 482 homes (46.88%), which have paid their dues. We are continuing to send our emails and contacting homeowners who have not yet paid.

Leslie Kian reported on the status of the wood Woodside sign project with the Boy Scouts. They are currently accessing damage and will move forward as they have a plan.

Timberside Closure

Marian Richardson reported that the Civic Club has asked Councilman Larry Green about the possibility of closing Timberside due to recent car accidents, security and traffic concerns. Previously the Civic Club had looked into the closure of the Timberside to the feeder road but this had been previously blocked by the HFD. But now that there is a new Fire Stations on Stella Link this may now be something that we can discuss.

Some residents expressed concern with lack access to Timberside and the possibility of increased traffic on Woodvalley. The Board will communicate any response from Councilman Green and then have further discussions with the subdivision.
