ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is THE WOODSIDE CIVIC CLUB

ARTICLE II

The Corporation is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purpose for which the Corporation is organized is to assume to a material extent, various civic activities (solely for purely public charity) which otherwise might become obligations or duties of the community or State. In so doing said activities shall be wholly beneficial to the public and said Corporation is organized exclusively for wholly charitable and educational purposes and shall be conducted at all times so as to qualify for exemption under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law). Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this Corporation shall not, except in an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

ARTICLE V

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors or officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the Fourth Article hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise influencing or attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign or on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision hereof, the Corporation shall not, to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

ARTICLE VI

If this Corporation is ever dissolved the Board of Directors shall, after paying off all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organizations organized and operated for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at all times qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the comparable provision of any future United States Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine, and written records of such shall be kept of said disposal transactions.

ARTICLE VII

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 3623 Sun Valley Drive, Houston, Texas 77025 and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Anthony D. Sheppard, Attorney.

ARTICLE VIII

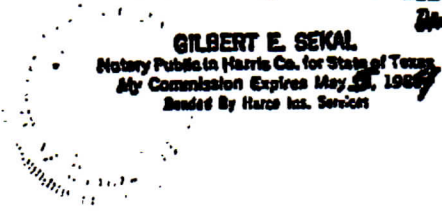
